About the Port Lincoln Hospital

The Port Lincoln Hospital is a modern 48 bed facility that provides a range of acute clinical services including an Emergency Department, medical, surgical, obstetric, chemotherapy and renal dialysis. The Operating Rooms Department is operational week days with emergency on call services also being also available. It is estimated that there will be approximately 300 births in 2019.

The Port Lincoln Hospital offers a comprehensive Transition to Professional Practice Program (TPPP) for nurses to assist in the transition from student nurse to an independent professional in a supportive environment. The program is based upon individual learning aims and is tailored to the individual's goals. The program is supported through a mentoring program and has a Registered Nurse/Midwife who oversees the program.
